As an adult, Rick worked with youth in prisons, discovering their inner problems, and helping them to view the world in a more compassionate manner.

RICK ADAM has been performing, teaching, and inspiring people of all ages for over 20 years. He has combined his extensive theatrical and musical experience and training with his own life experience to create original theatrical performances that both educate and entertain. Adam has toured widely, from elementary schools to colleges to maximum security prisons, from Rhode Island to Russia. He has acted with the Trinity Square Repertory Company and has appeared in films and on television. He was recently featured on a PBS special on one-man bands in America, which is now in the permanent collection of the Smithsonian Institute.

TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS

- A clean, clear 20' x 20' performing space. (With a raised, stable, stage whenever possible).
- Performance space should be available 1 and 1/2 hours before and after the performance.
- Assistance with unloading and loading of equipment.
- Adequate lighting and electricity (standard outlet).
- Room should be able to be darkened for hand shadows whenever possible.
- A clean, private, room for dressing.
- Outdoor shows should be in an area removed from street or traffic sounds whenever possible.
- Outdoor shows should be on a covered space or have an indoor rain site.
